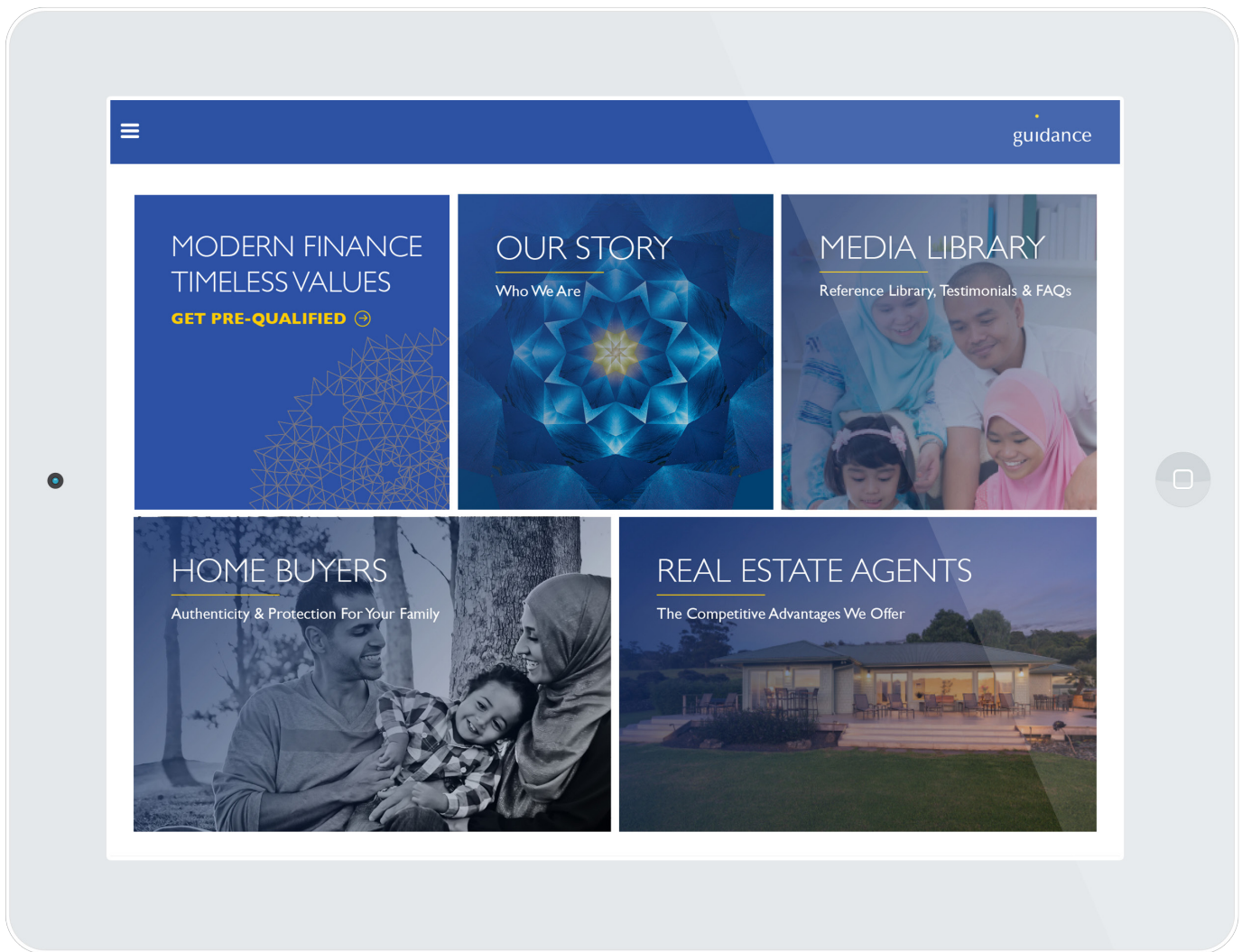

Homepage

There are five tiles on the homepage which will take the user to different sections of the application:

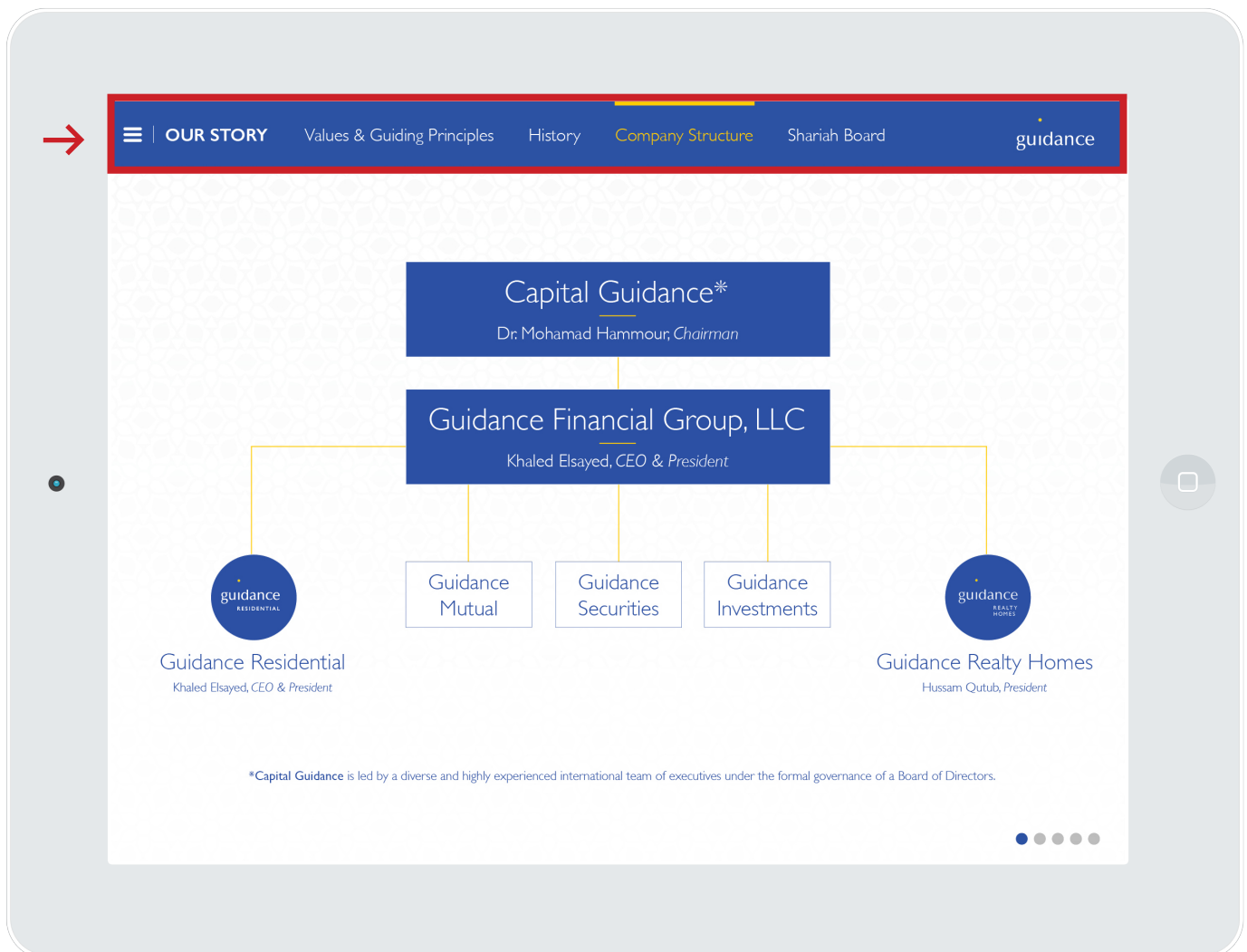
1. Pre-Qualification
2. Our Story
3. Media Library
4. Home Buyers
5. Real Estate Agents



Navigation

1. HEADER LINKS

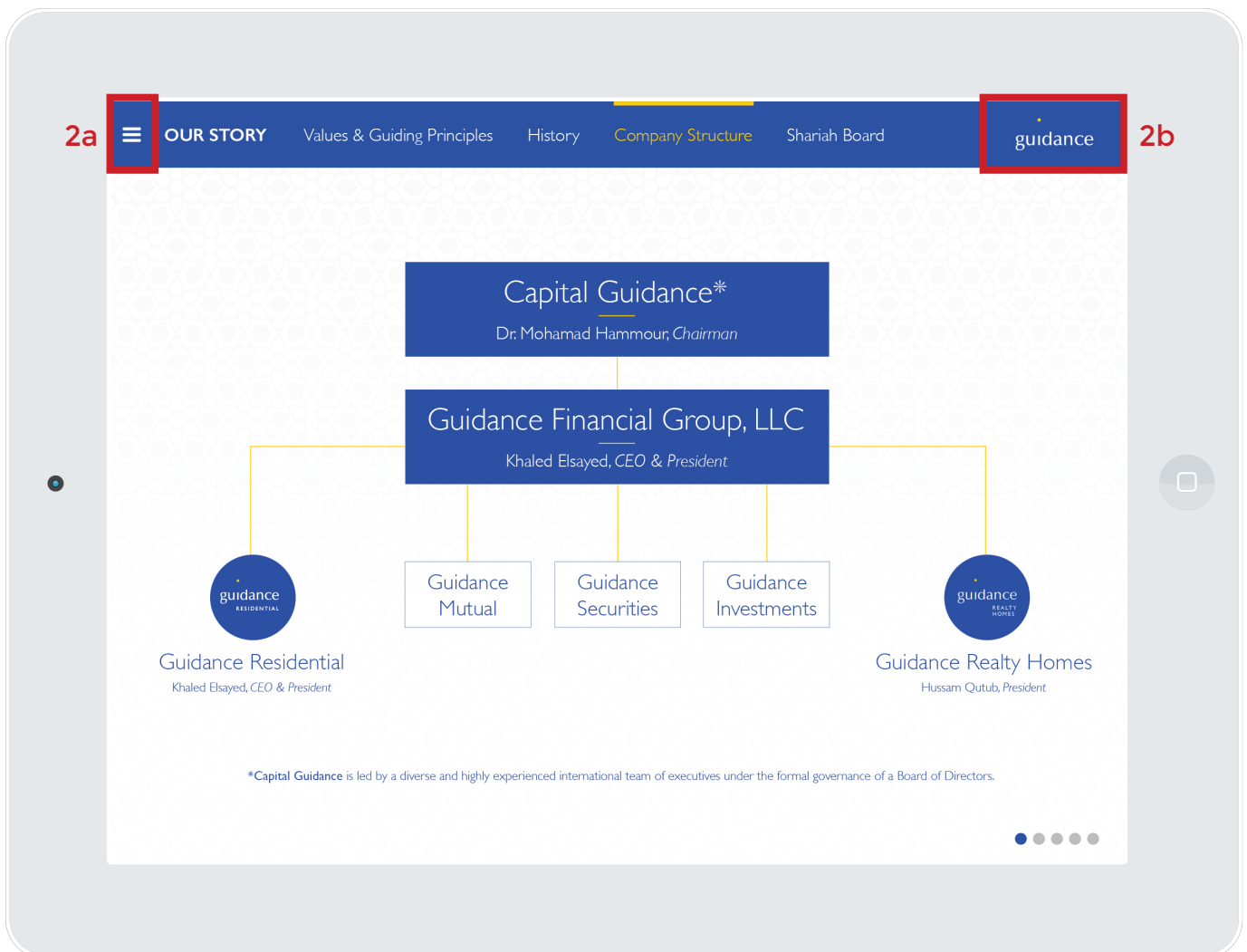
Once a user selects a tile from the homepage, there will be header links at the top of the page to indicate where in the app they are. These items are also clickable and will allow the user to navigate to other sub-sections. Please see the example highlighted in red. This shows that the user is in the “Company Structure” section of “Our Story.”

2. HAMBURGER MENU

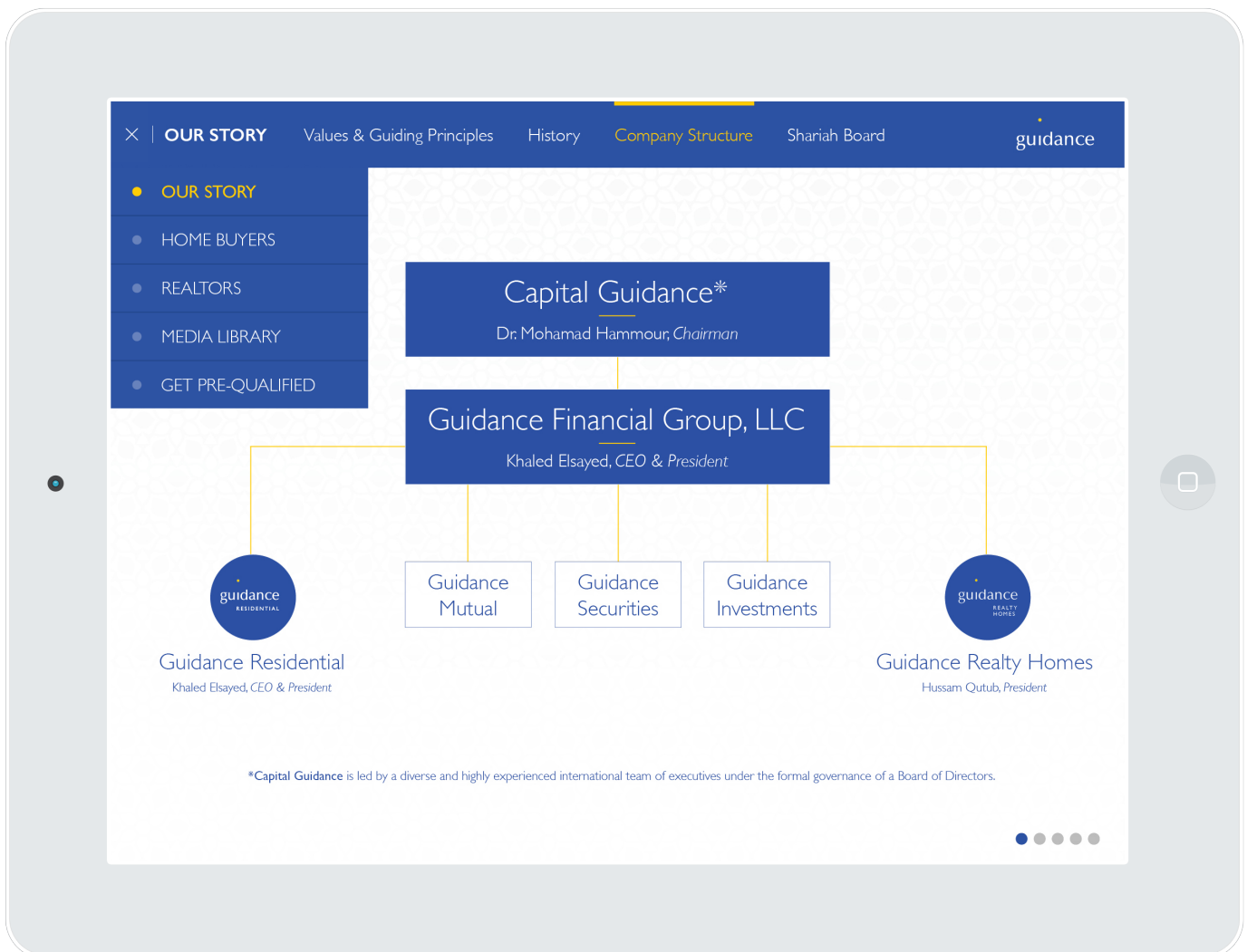
There is also a hamburger menu in the header which enables the user to select and navigate to other sections of the app (please refer to item 2a). If at any point the user would like to return to the main homepage, simply click on the Guidance logo (please refer to item 2b).

2. HAMBURGER MENU (Example)

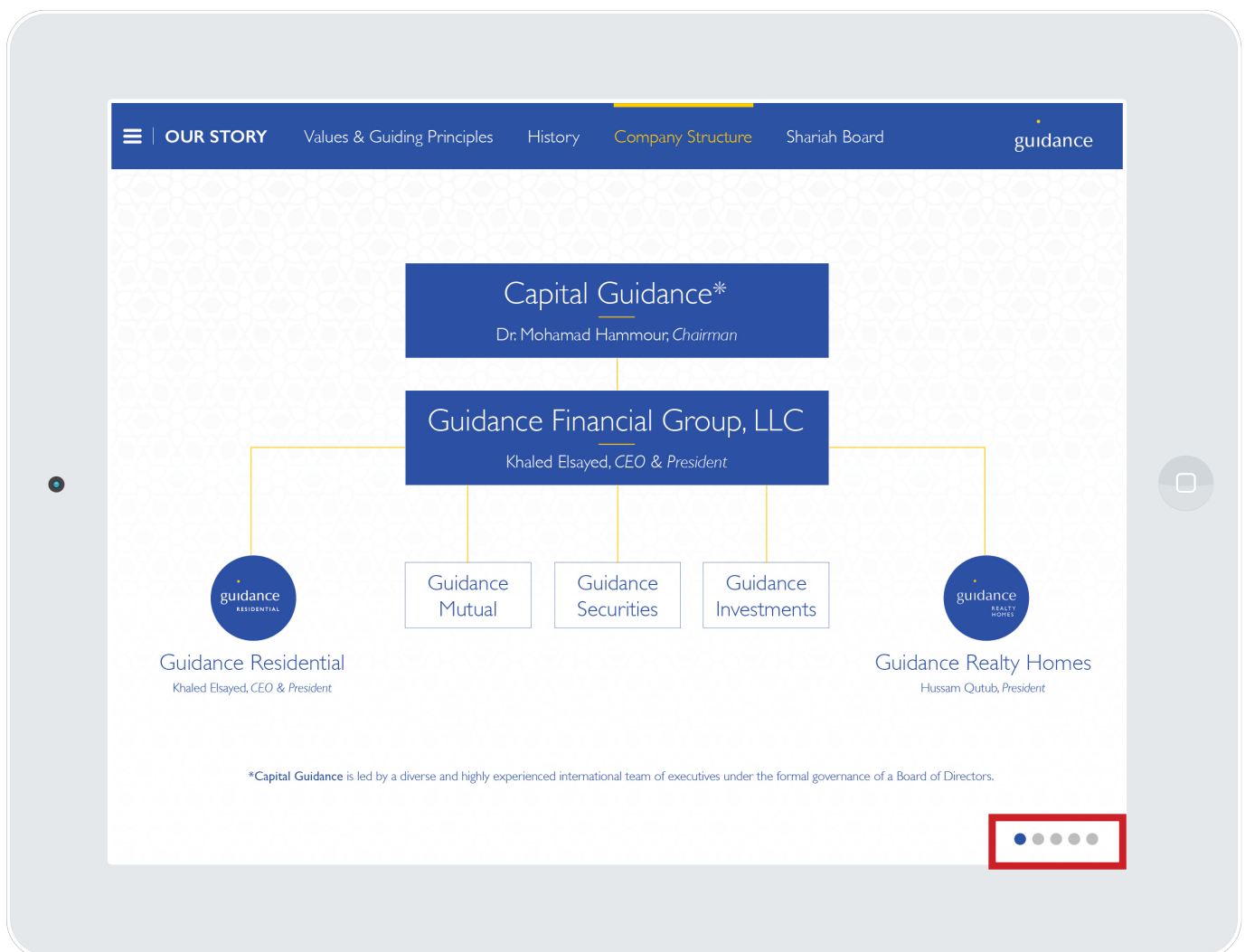
The example below shows what the hamburger menu will look like once selected. The section of the app the user is on will be highlighted (“Our Story” in the example below). To navigate to another section, select one of the other options.

3. BREADCRUMBS

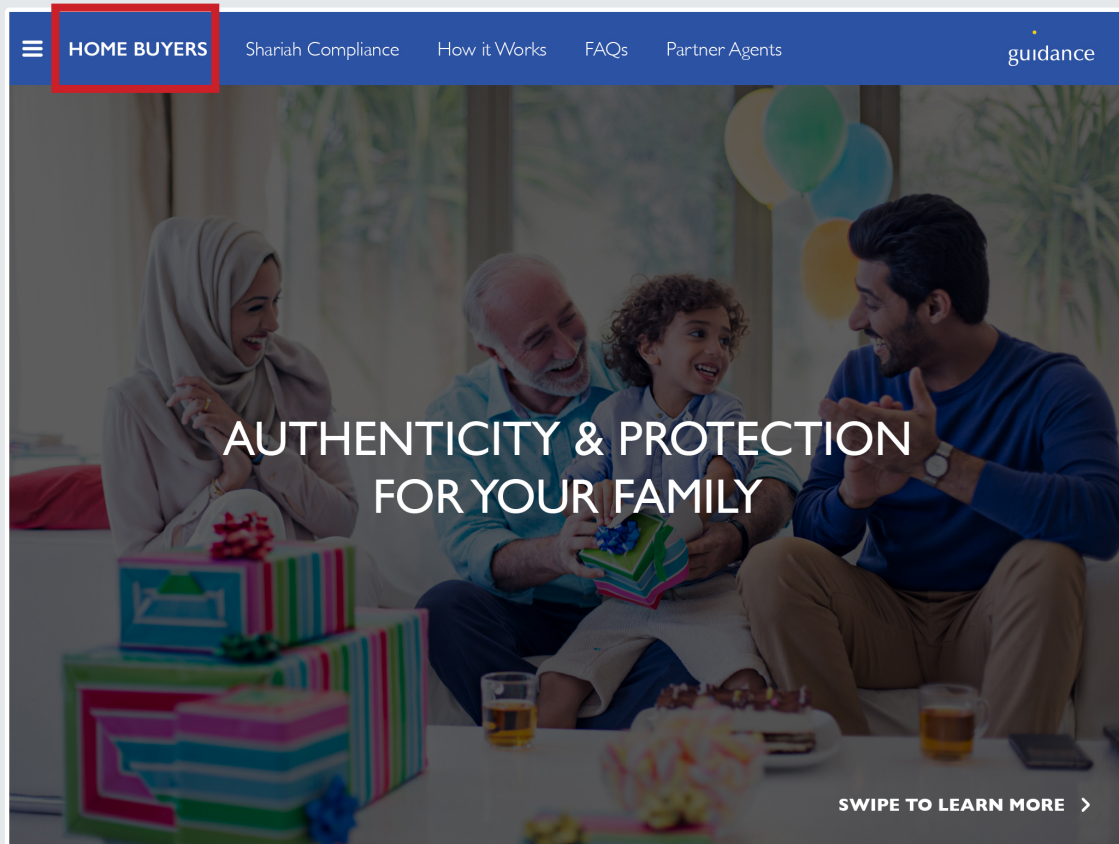
There are sections in the app that have multiple pages associated with that topic. In the example below, the user will see that there are 5 pages in the “Company Structure” section. The first blue dot indicates that they are on the first page.



Splash Pages

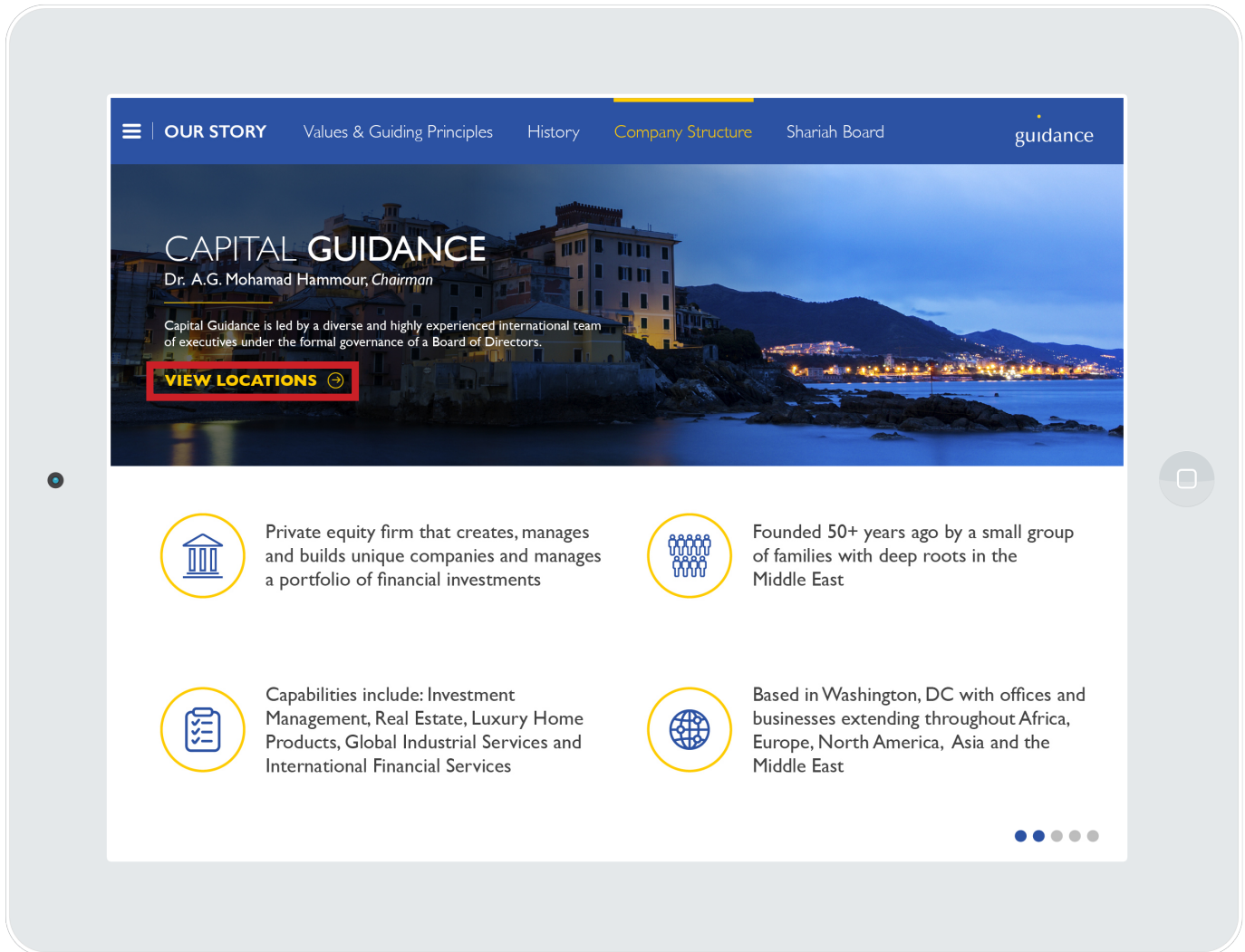
Before each section, there is an introductory page that shows that the user is about to move on to another part of the app.

The user will recognize that they are on a “splash page” when there are no items highlighted in the header bar. The title of the upcoming section can also be found here (see highlighted portion in the example below).



Pop-ups

There are some sections of the app where the user is able to drill-down for more information. The information will be shown in a “pop-up” which can be triggered by tapping an arrow similar to the one in the example highlighted below.

To exit a pop-up, the user must tap on the “x” button which can be found on upper right side of the page. Please reference the image below.
